Re Kings Court Masonic Centre.

Thank you for booking with us and in accordance with Government guidelines we are pleased to advise that the Centre will reopen fully as from the 19th July. The restrictions on numbers has been lifted so the Centre will return to normal and there is no requirement to maintain social distancing.

However, whilst Government restrictions have been lifted the Board of Directors have decided, in the short term, to continue with a couple of safety measures within our building. These are partly for our collective safety but more importantly for the safety of those who have yet to be double vaccinated or even vaccinated; and hopefully to protect us all against the current delta strain which is spreading so rapidly.

Firstly, on entering the building face masks will be worn whilst walking around the hallway, bar and toilets down stairs until you are seated. Wearing a mask is also necessary when ordering drinks at the bar, in addition drink orders should be made in front of the plastic screens not at the side of the bar.

Secondly, continue to sanitise your hands when entering the building and ideally before and after handling any equipment.

These are simple restrictions that the Board feels are in the best interest of everyone visiting the Centre to comply with, in order to ensure a healthy environment for all within the Centre.
